The University, and its accrediting body, require a 3 and 1/2 day on site residency seminar for all MSCC students. This is a requirement of all students, there are no exceptions.

The YIEP program residency will be in the NY-NJ area.

The first residency will be January 12-15, 2020, Sunday noon through Wednesday noon. We expect the second residency to be in mid January 2021. Please check the academic calendar.

In order to apply for State licensure, the student must take and pass a national exam, offered by NBCC, National Board for Certified Counselors, please see [www.nbcc.org](http://www.nbcc.org).

The examination is not required for graduation.

The exam is given in April and October of each year, at various sites throughout the United States.

Bellevue University facilitates the exam.

Please discuss with your advisor when you should take the exam.

YIEP and BELLEVUE UNIVERSITY will work closely with the student to obtain a placement for the Practicum and Internships (and to date we have been successful), however, such placement is ultimately the responsibility of the student.
